- All dancers must have a current RSOBHD registration card to be able to enter and must be brought on the day. If you do not have a card on the day, you will be unable to dance.

## **COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY PROTOCOLS AND VENUE RISK ASSESSMENT**

1. Dancers are asked to arrive ready to dance – dressed and hair done
2. All adults will need to provide details for track and trace purposes either by scanning provided QR code or leaving personal contact details on the day. QR codes will be available on individual seats.
3. All attendees above the age of 12 are strongly encouraged to have 2 negative lateral flow tests in the week leading up to the event
4. Four dancing sessions on the day – timings detailed beside each session. Please note you will not be allowed entry to the venue prior to arrival time and all dancers/adults will need to leave the venue at the end of their session promptly.
5. All dancers can be accompanied by one adult to the session, no additional spectators can attend.
6. Dancing siblings may attend a session they are not dancing in – please notify the organiser by email if an additional seat is needed and in which session. This will be confirmed once entries have been allocated.
7. The hall will be cleaned/sanitised by employed staff of the venue and organisation helpers, before all sessions begin.
8. Hand sanitiser will be provided. This will be available at the entrance and exit door as well as at numerous points throughout the inside of the hall itself.
9. All signage within the building must be followed – please follow all one-way systems.
10. Ventilation – the venue ventilation system will be utilised. Fire exits within the venue will also be opened.
11. 2m distancing will be provided in dance area
12. 1m distancing will be provided in the line-up area
13. 1m distancing will be provided in seating area
14. This is a seated event so audience must remain seated – including when watching the event
15. Dancers should not touch swords, stewards will ensure swords are in the correct place at the start of each dance
16. Face coverings must be worn within venue
17. Music will be played through a sound system
18. June McMahan and Elizabeth Gollan are the registered Covid Officers for this event
19. All rules are subject to change following national advice and guidance
20. Any significant change will be notified to all participants via email prior to the event
