- All dancers must have a current RSOBHD registration card to be able to enter. The card must be brought on the day. If you do not have a card on the day, you will be unable to dance.

- Entries £3 per dance and £5 for adult entrance and programme, if attending multiple sessions you need only pay for one adult admission.
- Entries open Sunday 31st October 8am, no entries received before this will be accepted
- Teacher spaces may be allocated after entries have closed
- A waiting list will be operated for any dancer who does not get allocated an initial space
- Dancer numbers will be issued on day during registration

COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY PROTOCOLS AND VENUE RISK ASSESSMENT

1. It is still preferred that dancers arrive ready to dance, however a dressing space will be available for dancers at arrival time – no clothes/outfits can be left in this space once the session begins.
2. A dressing space will be available at end of session but must be cleared within 15 minutes of end of session
3. All adults will need to provide details for track and trace purposes either by scanning provided QR code or leaving personal contact details on the day. QR codes will be available on individual seats.
4. All attendees above the age of 12 are recommended to have 2 negative lateral flow tests in the week leading up to the event
5. Five dancing sessions on the day – timings detailed at top of entry form. Please note you will not be allowed entry to the venue prior to arrival time and all dancers/adults will need to leave the venue at the end of their session promptly.
6. All dancers can be accompanied by one adult to the session, no additional family members can attend to spectate
7. Dancing siblings may attend a session they are not dancing in – please notify the organiser by email if an additional seat is needed and in which session.
8. The hall will be cleaned/sanitised by employed staff of the venue, before all sessions begin.
9. Hand sanitiser will be provided. This will be available at the entrance and exit door as well as at numerous points throughout the inside of the hall itself.
10. All signage within the building must be followed
11. Ventilation – all the windows within the hall will be open throughout the event for ventilation
12. 1m distancing will be provided within line up area
13. 2m distancing will be provided in dance area
14. 1m distancing will be provided in seating area
15. This is a seated event so audience must remain seated
16. Dancers should not touch swords, stewards will ensure swords are in the correct pace at the start of each dance
17. Face coverings should be worn within venue
18. Music will be played through sound system
19. Jacqueline Aird is the registered Covid Officer for this event
20. All rules are subject to change following national advice and guidance
21. Any significant change will be notified to all participants via email prior to the event

As this will be our last event for 2021 and in the month of December we would encourage adults to wear Christmas jumpers to support what will be our festive themed event.
