Restricted Premier Sections

Entry to the Restricted Premier Section is confined to the following categories.

- Premier Dancers who have not won an Overall Trophy in 2021
- Premier Dancers who have not placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Overall Championship Lineup including all Open/Closed Championships Worldwide in 2018, 2019, 2020 & 2021

There is no restriction on the Premier Section and any Premier Dancer may enter that.

Each of the above Sessions are limited to a maximum of 40 dancers per session Age Groups & Timings may be altered once all entries are received and will be confirmed via our facebook page prior to the event.

- This Competition is operated under the rules of the RSOBHD (Reg No BK2)
- The Adjudicators decision will be final
- Sections will be grouped according to entries received and notified on the day we will endeavour to have as many age groups as possible. Each session is limited as above plus any sibling dancers in same session.
- Age will apply on date of the Competition
- All Competitors must bring Registration Cards and include the Number & Image with Entry Form
- The Organiser accepts no responsibility for loss of equipment or injury.
- Dancers must observe the RSOBHD code of ethics and dress appropriately at all times
- No video or photography permitted during the event. Photographs of trophy winners may be taken but please ensure you seek parental permission for any photographs of other children if posting on social media
- Most Points & Runner up Trophies will be awarded for each age group over all dances
- No Trophies will be awarded in Primary Sections
- Entry fee is £3 per dance (dancers do not pay Door Entry)
- No Entries will be accepted in the Hall and no entry money will be refunded.
- Door Entry Ticket £5 per Adult £3.50 Concession to be included with your entry fee (1 per dancer)
- Adult door entry is only paid once even if you have sibling dancers in different sessions
- Parents with sibling dancers in sessions running at the same time in both halls should ensure there is an Adult with the dancer in each hall. No Parents, Teachers or Dancers will be permitted to move between halls.

- Entries received after each session is full will be placed on a waiting list for cancellations.
- Numbers will be placed on your table at the start of your session on the day.

- Teacher Entry Free and will be allocated if space allows. Teachers wishing to attend must notify by email of section to attend and may be allocated a seat. Priority of space will be given to dancers first.

Covid 19 Important Information

Before the Event

- Everyone 12 years & over attending this event are strongly encouraged to have 2 negative lateral flow tests in the week running up to the event on the Tuesday and the Friday. Lateral flow tests can be ordered from <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests>
- Attendance at this Highland dancing event (any participant displaying COVID Symptoms)
Participants must stay at home if they: develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (new continuous cough or a high temperature or loss of/ change in sense of smell or taste)
Have been told by track and trace teams to self-isolate or Live with someone displaying symptoms
Consult NHS Inform for further information on what to do next and when to seek further medical advice.
Household members of those with symptoms should follow the guidance for households with possible COVID-19 infection on NHS Inform
- Entries should be sent by email not before 9am on Saturday 23rd October 2021 for Premier and Saturday 30th October for Pre-Premier and payment should be made by bank transfer when confirmed. On receipt of your entry, if accepted, you will receive a confirmation email and be allocated a table/seating in the Main Hall or the Club Hall (or both if you have sibling dancers in the same sessions).
- Parents of sibling dancers should notify the organiser if additional seats are required for siblings and details of the sessions required to allow appropriate seating to be allocated.

On the Day of the Event

- Anyone showing symptoms of Covid-19 on the day should report directly to the Covid Officer Elizabeth Wren.
- When arriving at the venue by car please give consideration and space to other people exiting their cars.
- Please do not arrive before your allocated entry time.
- As you enter the venue Turn Right to the Main Hall or Straight on to the Club Hall. There will be a QR Poster at the entrance to each hall for tracing purposes. The adult of your party should scan this with their camera phone and fill in their contact name, telephone number and number of people in your party. There will also be a manual list option to complete if you do not have a camera phone. This information will be held for 21 days.
- Dancers are requested to arrive in their kilt ready to dance
- You must sit at the table/seating allocated to you and not circulate with other tables or between halls.
- This is an indoor seated event and you must remain seated throughout.
- Dancers can warm up outside before the competition commences and during the competition at their line up area. Dancers should remain 1m apart at all times.
- Dancers should be pre-registered by sending a copy of the front of their card with their entry details which will be held for 21 days. Dancers numbers will be placed in a bag on your table/seating in the hall for your arrival. Remember your own pins. Pre-Premier Dancers should put their Registration Card in this bag and take it to their line up area at their first dance and place it on the table next to the Steward.
- In accordance with Government guidance face masks should be worn in the venue when entering, moving to the toilet or outside or moving around the building. They may be removed when seated at your table to allow you to eat or drink. (unless you have a medical exemption)
- Dancers must wear masks until they are called to line up. Masks are not required when walking to and from line up area or when dancing.
- There will be a one way system in operation on the dance floor and around the hall in each hall please familiarise yourself with this from the layout plan provided.
- There are no canteen facilities available at this time however you are permitted to bring your own drinks and snacks. Please dispose of any rubbish in the rubbish bag provided at your table/seat, tie it up securely and leave it on your table/seat for collection at the end of your session.
- Hand Sanitiser will be available at the entrance/exit, the medal & trophy tables and at the line up areas.
- Results will be announced for each age group at the end of each session and dancers will be invited up to collect their prizes and registration cards which will be placed in their bag.
- After the prizegiving please exit the hall with all your belongings ASAP to allow cleaning for the next session.
- We aim to keep everyone safe during our event at Dalkeith Highland Dancing Competition and we appreciate your cooperation with the additional measures we have put in place. We hope you all enjoy your day and look forward to a more normal competition next year. Happy Dancing!
