1. This competition will operate under the rules of the RSOBHD.
2. In all cases, the adjudicators' decisions will be final.
3. The age of the competitor is as on the day of the competition.
4. All competitors must show current RSOBHD registration card before being allowed to compete.
5. All competitors must be prepared to make up reel sets when required.
6. Dancers must observe the RSOBHD code of ethics and dress appropriately at all times
7. Entries will not be refunded unless the class is cancelled by the organisers.
8. The organisers accept no responsibility or liability for any loss or injury howsoever sustained.
9. Competitors changing status after the closing date should notify the organisers prior to the competition.
10. No video or photography permitted during the event.
11. No alcohol or smoking in any part of the building.

As an organiser, we are trying to promote a Covid-safe environment. 4. A large changing room will be used for dancers to change.
5. Timings may be subject to change, particularly if the entry is sufficient that the organiser decides to add extra sessions to enable suitable spacing in the hall.
6. Hand sanitiser will be provided by the organiser.
