VSCHDI Generic Rules for Competition Syllabi

The Victorian State Committee of Highland Dancing Inc A0009626W

Affiliated with the Australian Board of Highland Dancing Incorporated

(Royal Scottish Official Board Highland Dancing)

- 1. This Competition is registered under RSOBHD rules as adopted by ABHDI.
- 2.Any rules pertaining to competition or championship released by RSOBHD or ABHDI from the time of printing this schedule to the date of the competition or championship, will be adhered to. Any change to rules should be announced prior to commencement of the competition or championship.
- 3. The eight (8) dance rule must be observed. No Premier dancer may compete in more than eight (8) dances at any one competition.
- 4. Dancers must be registered and quote their current registration number when entering competitions and present registration card at competition. Prizes cannot be given until card is sighted.
- 5. Competitors dance at own risk.
- 6. Competitors must be ready when called, otherwise they render themselves liable to forfeit dance.
- 7. Dancers must "fill in" if requested by the organiser. If a competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason the Organiser has the right to enforce Rule 1g) D Judges, RSOBHD Rules and Regulations, which reads: "During the course of a competition the comportment and behaviour of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the Judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the Judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such conduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the Judge to the Organiser. In serious cases, the Judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the Organiser and to the RSOBHD.
- 8. All Trophy winners must be dressed in Kilt or National costume for presentation and be wearing their competitor's number.
- 9. The ABHDI direct that dancers use dressing rooms to change and that they dress fully, appropriately and respectably when in public at competitions. The ABHDI recommend that teachers and competition organisers advise the dancers to dress appropriately and modestly.
- 10. Any complaint made by an individual dancer against the organisation or adjudication of an event must be in writing giving the complainant's full name and address, and shall be lodged with the organiser if possible on the day of the event and certainly not later than 48 hours after the event. Such complaint to be accompanied by a set fee which is refundable if the protest is upheld. Current fee is \$5.00.
- 11. Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 12. There are no restrictions on the usage of electronic recording equipment, provided permission is obtained from the organisers and judges and it does not interfere with the smooth organisation of the competition / championships or in any way restricts the view of the judge/s.
- 13. Judges and organisers should bear in mind that the judge's decision is final and cannot be subjected to an electronic recording replay.
- 14. Teachers, interested parties or any other unauthorised person must not communicate with judges during the competition. All enquiries to the official table.
- 15. The Scrutineering system as set in RSOBHD booklet is to be strictly adhered to at all competitions in Australia. Points shall be awarded as follows: 1st 137, 2nd 91, 3rd 71, 4th 53, 5th 37, 6th 23. Titles and aggregates will be scrutineered to the number of prizes being awarded in individual/overall events.
- 16. The Committee/Association reserves the right to alter the program if deemed necessary.
- 17. The Committee reserves the right to deal with any matter not covered by these rules.
- 18. Unauthorised use of cameras, imaging and digital devices is prohibited, including recording using mobile phones.
- 19. It is prohibited to use any device capable of recording or transmitting visual images without the organiser's permission.
- 20. Following the awards parents may photograph their own child or others with parental permission but be highly aware that there must not be other children in shot whose privacy must be protected.
- 21. As organisers of this event, we plan to photograph winning competitors for the purpose of posting on our Website or Facebook page. If anyone wishes to opt out of this process, please let us know.
- 22. The Committee/Association will monitor and adhere to current COVID19 Government requirements as set out on https://www.coronavirus.vic.gov.au

Please note: The Organiser has the right to choose one of the following -

- If age groups are advertised there must be a disclaimer on the schedule to cover changing of ages due to entries received OR
- If advertising age groups without disclaimer, competition organiser must stay with the age groups advertised.

- 23. The organiser reserves the right to alter age groups if deemed necessary
- 24. Refunds will only be given on production of a medical certificate dated on the day of/or prior to the date of the competition received by the Competition Secretary within 14 days of the event.
- 25. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes in classification, the Competition Secretary must be notified PRIOR to competition day.
- 26. **ENTRIES close** Monday, 26th February, 2024. Late entries will be accepted until Monday, 18TH March, 2024 and will incur a late fee of **\$20.00**. No entries will be received at the competition with the exception of the Champion of Champions Championship of Australia which will not incur a late fee. Any competitor gaining a 1st, 2nd or 3rd placing in an ABHDI or RSOBHD recognised Championship after the closing date and prior to the event, will be eligible to enter. Please notify Competition Secretary in writing if eligible to enter after closing date.
- 27. NOT PERMITTED: Non-slip agents or water for shoes, or heeled shoes on courts/stages

Dancers can choose to dance in Premier supporting events, or Premier with Restrictions supporting events, but cannot enter both.

32. Ruling re Premier Supporting Events

If dancer chooses to enter Premier Supporting Events, he/she cannot compete in Premier with Restrictions Supporting Events.
