Dances and Steps for all Championships as laid down by the RSOBHD for 2024.

Annual trophies are awarded to the first 6 overall dancers in each Championship.

Cash prizes are awarded in the 16 & under 18 years and 18 years & over age groups.

An overall trophy is awarded to the dancer with the most points over the 7-11 years, 12-15 years, and 16 years & over Championships.

# Mrs Jessie Stewart Haggarty MBE Sword Challenge



To continue to pay tribute to the late Mrs Jessie Stewart Haggarty MBE, a Final will be held for the Sword Dance.

The first three places in the Sword Dance from the 7 & under 9 years, 9 years, 10 years, and 11 years championships qualify for the Juvenile Sword Dance Off. The first three places in the Sword Dance from the 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, and 15 years championships qualify for the Junior Sword Dance Off. The first six places in the Sword Dance from the 16 & under 18 years and 18 years & over championships qualify for the Senior Sword Dance Off. Steps as for Championship.

An annual trophy and a claymore sword and sheath to keep will be awarded to the winners, plus the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> places in each group will receive a prize to keep.

Dancer numbers will be issued on the day during registration.

- 1. All participants must abide by the Rules and Regulations and the Code of Ethics of the RSOBHD
- 2. Dancers must show a valid RSOBHD registration card prior to the competition starting
- 3. First to enter will be last to dance
- 4. Entries will be accepted upon payment of entry fee and admission
- 5. The dancer's age is taken as at the day of the competition
- 6. Age groups in any of the sections may be amended or amalgamated according to the number of entries
- 7. Timings for the sessions may be adjusted after entries have closed
- 8. Dancers should be prepared to fill in for the Reel if required
- 9. Dancers should remain in costume for the prize giving and trophy awards
- 10. The organiser accepts no responsibility for injury or loss of/damage to property or equipment
- 11. The adjudicators' decisions are final
- 12. No entry fees will be refunded unless the competition is cancelled
- 13. The use of video cameras and flash photography is strictly forbidden in the hall. This includes mobile phones and any form of tablets
- 14. The capacity for each session is 400
- 15. Practice mats are not permitted
