Restricted Premier Section Conditions

Entry to the Restricted Premier Section is confined to the following categories.

- Premier Dancers who have not won an Overall Trophy for their section in 2023 or 2024
- Premier Dancers who have not placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Overall Championship Lineup including all Open/Closed Championships Worldwide in 2021, 2022, 2023 & 2024
- Parents/carers should inform the organiser if a dancer needs to change category once entered.
- Premier Dancers can only enter one section as these will be danced at the same time and there are 7 dances.

COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY PROTOCOLS AND VENUE RISK ASSESSMENT

- This Competition is operated under the rules of the RSOBHD (Reg No BD1)
- The Adjudicators decision will be final
- Dancers are asked to arrive ready to dance – dressed and hair done. Changing facilities available for change of outfit.
- Any significant change will be notified to all participants via westpark monthly facebook and email prior to the event
- Sections will be grouped according to entries received and notified on the day we will endeavour to have as many age groups as possible.
- Age will apply on date of the Competition
- All Competitors must bring Registration Cards
- The Organiser accepts no responsibility for loss of equipment or injury.
- Dancers must observe the RSOBHD code of ethics and dress appropriately at all times
- No video or photography permitted during the event.
- Most Points & Runner up Trophies will be awarded for each age group over all dances. No Trophies will be awarded in Primary Sections
- No Entries will be accepted in the Hall and no entry money will be refunded.
- Entry Fee is per session. Entries includes dancer entry fee and entry for one adult per dancer and a programme.
- If you wish to bring any additional spectators please pay for these on arrival. Door entry Ticket £5.
- Adult door entry is only paid once even if you have sibling dancers in different sessions.
- Numbers will be placed on a table in the hall for collection on the day.
