☐ The rules and regulations of the R.S.O.B.H.D. will govern all dancing. Any rules pertaining to the competition released from
RSOBHD from time of printing this schedule and actual date of competition will be adhered to. Dancers are requested to observe
the RSOBHD Code of Ethics and general behavior
☐ All competitors must be registered with the RSOBHD registration scheme. Registration cards must be produced before
dancing
☐ The Judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered. Teachers interested parties or any other unauthorized
person must not communicate with judges during the competition. All queries on the day of competition should be directed to the
Competition Organizer
☐ The organisers reserve the right to adjust age groups according to entries received. Age will be taken as on the day of the event
☐ The Organisers reserves the right to refuse an entry, substitute a judge and/or alter the program at their discretion.
☐ Competitors changing status after the closing date should notify the organisers prior to the competition

COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY PROTOCOLS AND VENUE RISK ASSESSMENT

- 1. Dancers are to arrive dressed ready to dance, Outfit according to first dance and please warm up next to your seat, a changing room is available for national dance changes.
- 2. All adults will be requested to scan in using the QR CODE READER
- 4. Those over the age of 12 are strongly recommended to have 2 negative lateral flow tests in the week leading up to the event to ensure they are negative (Tuesday and Friday)
- **5**. Hall floor length is 23.6m x 13.5m. Attendance will be restricted to 90 people in the hall per session with one adult per dancer.
- 6. Two sessions on the day —Beginners/Novice/Primary 9.30 -12.45 (including results followed by sanitization/cleaning of the venue), Intermediate/Premier 1.45pm. Please do not arrive at the hall until half an hour before scheduled start time and only enter the hall once instructed to do so which will be after cleaning has been completed.
- 7. Dancing siblings may attend a session they are not dancing in but must remain seated with their family bubble please notify the organizer in application email if an additional seat is needed and in which session.
- 8. The hall will be cleaned/sanitized by Grampian cleaners on the morning of event and then again between sessions 1 and 2 by Grampian dance school parents, The hall will also be cleaned by The Venue staff at the end of the day once all attendees have exited this includes toilets which will be regularly cleaned throughout the day by The Venue staff.
- 9. Hand sanitizer will be provided by both the venue and the event organisers. This will be available at the entrance and exit door as well outside toilets and at numerous points throughout the inside of the hall itself.
- 10. The hall will contain numerous signage illustrating the importance of hand hygiene, social distancing and face masks throughout in the prevention of transmission of the virus. This will be displayed by the organisers.
- 11. The organisers will provide signage surrounding the one-way system that will be put in place for attendees during the day.
- 12. Ventilation Doors will remain open throughout the course of the day
- 13. There is a one-way system that the organizer will put in place. All dancers and all other attendees will enter via the side entrance and exit the hall via the main entrance.
- 14. RSOBHD recommendation is that attendees please stick to 1m social distancing once inside the hall
- 15. This is an indoor seated event so the audience must remain seated. Distancing will be put into place in the line-up area, dance area and seated area. The line-up area will have dance spots for each of the competitors to stand on before dancing that will keep them socially distanced at 1 meter, Mask must be worn in the seated area but not required to dance with it on. Mask must be worn in the changing room.
- 16. Dancers should not touch swords; stewards will ensure swords are in the correct position at the start of each dance.
- 17. Registered Covid Officer is Marena Cruse
- 18. Dancers will be asked to place their registration cards in a plastic bag when they register. This will be for Pre-Premier. Once collected, these will be stamped accordingly by an official and placed back inside a bag with the dancer's medals.

- 19. Music will be played through sound system.
