## COVID19 SAFETY MEASURES AND VENUE RISK ASSESSMENT

- Changing facilities will be provided for female and male dancers but please be mindful of keeping a safe distance from others and avoid overcrowding in changing areas..
- Please do not attend the event if you have any signs or symptoms of Covid 19.
- Timings of events are as listed on entry form .No admittance to the hall will be permitted before the given time for your session.
- 4. If a session runs slightly late, your entry to the hall may be delayed but everyone will be given adequate time to register and be seated before the session begins.
- 5. At the end of each session everyone must leave the venue as quickly as possible, in an orderly manner and with no unnecessary contact with others
- 6. Dancers can be accompanied by 1 adult at their session. Additional spectator seats may be available if session capacity has not been reached.
- 7. The hall and toilets will be cleaned and sanitised by hall staff and organisers between and during each session
- 8. External doors will be open throughout the event to provide ventilation.
- Hand sanitiser will be provided at several points within the venue and all attendees are encouraged to use it frequently during their time on the premises
- 10. Please maintain a reasonable distance from others in all areas and avoid any unnecessary movement around the venue.
- 11. The audience must remain seated as much as possible
- 12. Although no longer mandatory, we will be operating a one way system around the venue which will be clearly signposted and we would appreciate if everyone would follow this.
- 13. Dancers must use the markers in place in the line up and dance areas and must follow all one way systems around the dance area
- 14. Dancers must not share water bottles or any other items
- 15. Please wait until all results have been announced before leaving the hall
- 16. Dancers will receive their awards in a plastic bag after their group results are announced.
- 17. Limited canteen facilities will be available. You may bring your own food but all litter must be removed before you leave the venue.
- 18. Please try to avoid any gathering in groups outside the venue before entering or after leaving and try to observe social distancing when leaving or entering your car if you are parked close to others
