Premier Nationals = Barracks, Highland Laddie, Jig & Hornpipe

- Annual Trophies for Pre-Championship.
- The Trophies awarded in all sections must be returned in good condition.
- All dancing events will operate under the rules of the R.S.O.B.H.D.

- All Competitors must be registered with the R.S.O.B.H.D. registration scheme. Registration cards must be produced at registration.
