Entry Information:

- Opening date for entries is Friday 2nd October 2026 at 9.00am.
- Closing date for entries will be Friday 23rd October 2026 at 7.00pm.
- Entry fee for all dancers includes 1 parent/adult. programmes are available at the door for £3. Entry fees are as follows:
 - Primary = £8
 - Beginners/Novice = £20
 - Intermediate/Premier = £20
 - Additional spectators will be £2 entry at the door if not included in the dancer's entry.

- All dancers must produce a valid and current RSOBHD registration card on the day of the competition. Unfortunately, if this is not provided on the day **the dancer will not be able to dance.**
