

## Event Details and Conditions of Entry

1. Hall seating capacity is 400.
2. All participants must abide by Rules and Regulations, Code of Ethics and Child Protection Procedures of the RSOBHD.
3. Dancers must provide a current RSOBHD Registration Card prior to competing prior to starting.
4. Last to enter will be first to dance.
5. There will be changing spaces available which dancers must use when changing.
6. The Organiser will not be held responsible for any injury or loss or damage to equipment.
7. Practice mats are not permitted due to health and safety requirements.
8. Dancers cannot use any form of Rosin in the Centre.
9. The judges' decision is final.
10. Entry fees are non-refundable.
11. Starting times may be amended after closing date.
12. Dancers must report to their station on time and dance in the correct numerical order.
13. Dancers are excepted to 'fill in' for the Reel if required.
14. The dancer's age is taken as of the day of the competition.
15. A dancer changing status should notify the Organiser as soon as possible and no later than 10<sup>th</sup> June.
16. The Organiser reserves the right to amend/amalgamate age groups.
17. All dancers should remain in costume for prize giving.
18. The use of video cameras and flash photography is strictly forbidden. This includes mobile phones and any form of tablets.

20. The Organiser's decision is final on any matters not covered by the above conditions or RSOBHD regulations.
21. Entry Records will be electronically stored for one year from the date of the competition.
