CHOREOGRAPHY RULES:

- a) Beginners, Novice, Intermediate or Premier dancers registered with the RSOBHD at the time of the competition only.
- b) Two and a half minutes maximum.
- c) Music, theme, and costumes must be Christmas themed and Scottish, Celtic or Nautical in style. Music can be instrumental or vocal.
- d) Dance content should consist primarily of movements from Highland, Scottish National, Sailor's Hornpipe or Irish Jig books.
- e) Songs must be sent electronically to the organiser prior to the event using the same email address for the entry.
